Observatory MARGO was formed in 2014. The main direction of work is the search for asteroids and comets.

The equipment that is available in the Observatory:

1. 0,65 m, F/1.5 Hamilton telescope equipped with 4096×4096
 $9 \times 9 \mu\text{m}$ CCD
2. 2 x 0,3 m, F/1.5 GenonMax telescope (4096×4096
 $9 \times 9 \mu\text{m}$ CCD)

All of these telescopes provide extensive sky coverage to detect NEO and comets.
