I am the principal NEO observer at the Hampshire Astronomical Group and have been doing follow-up and confirmation observations of NEOs from J69 since 2005. The North Observatory is owned by Hampshire Astronomical Group at Clanfield, Hampshire in the UK and is equipped with a 0.40m f/4.5 Newtonian telescope. With my Starlight Xpress H16 CCD, I can reach about +19 magnitude and I have enclosed the links to the websites at NEODyS and to Jost Jahn's website for J69 where you can see the work done.
